SUMMARY

Purpose

Honor male students of color from Texas high schools who have been innovators, creators, or game-changers in their schools or communities, whose contributions have been both visible and impactful, and whose acts and deeds of service have sought to make their world a better place.

Eligible Applicants

Male students of color (African-American, Asian-American, Hispanic, Native American, Multi-racial) enrolled in grades 9 to 12 in a district, charter, alternative, vocational/technical, faith-based, or private school in Texas.

Application

- Completed Written Application
- Up to 3 Letters of Support from Adults or Peers

Selection Criteria

Ideal candidates for this award will –

- Promote changes in their schools or communities to improve the education and affirmative development of their peers or help others
- Demonstrate excellence in school and serve as role models for their peers
- Express a commitment to continue to serve innovators and change agents in the future

Award Recipients

- Receive \$1,000 scholarship
- Honored at Award Breakfast during 2017 COSEBOC Gathering of Leaders in Austin
- Participate in two-day Youth Gathering held during the 2017 COSEBOC Gathering of Leaders
